Your goal: Stop jumping on you and others


Begin this way. Do not encourage a pup or dog to stretch up to greet you, instead, crouch down to his level and then greet him. Because it is enjoyable to them, most pups/dogs enjoy the annoying habit of jumping on people to greet them.

The Fix. Whenever the pup jumps on you, simply grasp both front paws securely, holding them up long enough for it to become uncomfortable in the standing position then put the pup down gently. When the pup experiences this response consistently, he will avoid jumping.

Both prospective members and non-members are welcome. The club holds numerous special events including two breed Specialties shows each year, which includes Obedience and Rally. 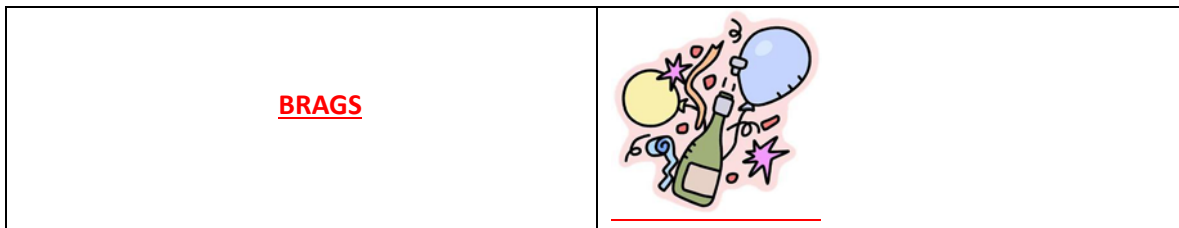
Classes held – each Tuesday . **Start Time: 7:30 p.m.**
