Beat The Heat!

This summer is already HOT HOT HOT. Please remember your dogs in the heat. Our club members know that when a German Shepherd Dog must be kept outdoors, he needs shade, and plenty of water just to stay alive, especially during the late afternoons. If you can't or won't bring your dog indoors into the air conditioning when the temperature soars into the nineties, there are other ways you can keep your best friends comfortable during the hot summer months.

One of my favorite ways to play is chase with the water hose! If you don't have a swimming pool in your backyard you can get a plastic kiddie pool, fill it up with water in a shady spot, and let your pooch splash around with a ball or two.

Keep a spray bottle of cold water handy, especially when traveling. Spray water onto the pads of your dog's feet and into his or her mouth, like the professional handlers do to keep their dogs cool in the show ring. Cold treats like ice cubes, frozen yogurt, and even a little ice cream are favorites. Fans help a lot and keep mosquitos and flies away.

I'm sure you all know walking your dog on BLACK PAVEMENT in the heat is a big NO NO! It will burn the pads of your dog's feet quicker than you may realize. Remember the five second rule ... hold the back of your hand on the ground for at least five seconds. If the ground burns your hand, it's too hot to walk your dog! And of course, *never* leave your dog in the car in the summer. Even if you think it's cool enough in the shade, windows down, etc ... you never know when someone else might think otherwise and call the police to "rescue" your dog.

Stay cool, stay in the shade, and enjoy summer!

AKC Breeders of Merit

Breeders of Merit are listed on the websites of the American Kennel Club, The German Shepherd Dog Club of America, and the German Shepherd Dog Club of Atlanta. The requirements to be an AKC (American Kennel Club) Breeder of Merit are as follows:

1. Must have a history of at least five years of involvement with AKC events.
2. Must have earned AKC Conformation, Performance or Companion* event titles on a minimum of four dogs from AKC litters they bred/co-bred.
3. Must be a member of an AKC club.
4. Must certify that applicable health screens are performed on breeding stock as recommended by the Parent Club (OFA Hips/Elbows, GSDCA Temperament Test).
5. Must demonstrate a commitment to ensure 100% of puppies produced are AKC registered.

About the Club

Records are vague, but it seems that The German Shepherd Dog Club of Atlanta was founded in 1955 when a small group of breeders and owners interested in the German Shepherd Dog met in Atlanta, Georgia.



The first President was Mrs. Michelle Leathers Billings who passed away in October 2013. The purpose of the club was the improvement of the breed. Today, the club's goal is the same. Through programs and activities, members learn about all aspects of the German Shepherd Dog, including mental and physical development; the breed standard; working ability; breeding; care and rearing of puppies, etc.

Programs are presented at monthly meetings held on the second Thursday of month, except for July, October, and December. Meetings are at 8:00 PM. Both prospective members and non-members are welcome. The club holds numerous special events including two breed Specialty shows each year and also Obedience and Rally competitions. Puppy matches, Temperament Testing and AKC Good Citizen tests are scheduled through the year.

In July, at the Annual Awards Banquet, trophies are presented to members whose dogs have earned titles over the year. A Holiday party is held in December.
